Girls Volleyball Fall 2025 and Boys Volleyball Spring 2026


Dear parents,



Step 4

RESERVE YOUR TAX CREDIT AMOUNT BEFORE DECEMBER 31

Click "submit" and you will receive an email from the MO State Treasurer's office. Print and save your confirmation number.

Step 5

WRITE A CHECK TO THE BRIGHT FUTURES FUND

Write a check to the Bright Futures Fund for the amount of the tax credits reserved. Mail the check within 30 days of your reservation and no later than December 31 to: Bright Futures Fund, P.O. Box 419037, Kansas City, MO, 64141. After your funds are received and verified, you will receive an email receipt from the State Treasurer's Office. Include the receipt and a MO-TC form with your state income tax filing.

- > Reserved tax credits are equal to 100% of an eligible contribution and can be used for up to 50% of the donor's annual tax liability.
- > For the current MO-TC form, visit BrightFuturesFund.org OR search MO-TC at: https://dor.mo.gov/forms/
- Tax credits may be carried forward for four additional tax years. Tax credits are nonrefundable, non-transferable, and cannot be sold.
